Sirin Art Studio Class Make-up and Cancelation Policy

Make-up classes

As our studio is growing we recognize the need to come up with a class make-up policy that would be fair to everyone. Our goal is to avoid overcrowding and disruption in the groups "hosting" make-up students. We do understand that unforeseen circumstances sometimes occur, so we will offer a limited number of make-up classes per session:

- 1. A maximum of one make-up class can be arranged per 4-week or 5-week sessions, and a maximum of two per 10-week session.
- 2. Make-up classes must be arranged within the next 6 weeks (while studio is in session) and cannot be carried over to the next school year or to be used as a credit.
- 3. No refunds will be issued for early withdrawal. Please, consider shorter sessions or the drop-in option when you sign up for classes.

We will do our best to catch up your student on their project, which might not be possible if they were working with special media (pottery clay, oil paint) or missed a group project. In this case a substitute project might be offered.

Inclement weather

In case of inclement weather, Sirin Art Studio will follow Anne Arundel County Public Schools closings and delays. If AACPS are not in session we will use our best judgment and your input to decide on whether to keep Studio open.

Classes canceled due to inclement weather will be rescheduled. If a student is unable to attend a class rescheduled by the studio, an additional make-up class will be offered.
